The basic function of this position is to play a part in the development, management and day-to-day operations of the Claims Department.

Key Responsibilities:

- Coordinate, adjust and process claims within the assigned portfolio of pro rata accounts including catastrophe, per risk, and casualty in accordance with the contract wording from first advice to final closure
- Review coverage, assess and establish reserves and authorize payments within the terms of coverage
- Liaise with Underwriters, Finance and other areas to ensure prompt and timely resolution of claims
- Coordinate all phases of the claims adjustment and payment process
- Maintain an electronic claims diary and filing systems
- Liaise and negotiate with brokers, clients, loss adjusters and lawyers as appropriate
- Liaise with external and internal auditors as required
- Ensure all claims information is entered accurately and in a timely manner
- Review monthly loss reports for data accuracy, diary checks and internal controls
- Assume responsibility for other ad hoc duties including assisting with the production and presentation of claims reports and management information reports, as required

Minimum Qualifications, Skills and Experience:

- Minimum 5 years claims handling experience within the re/insurance industry including a minimum of 2 years handling pro rata accounts
- Knowledge of property and casualty reinsurance preferred
