Dear Mr. Lightbourne and Messrs Hunt:

Subject: MediWaste Non-Compliance with Operating Licences OL-1185, 1186 and 1187

On behalf of the Environmental Authority, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources **TAKES NOTE** that:

1. Operating Licences OL-1185, OL-1186, OL-1187, issued to MediWaste Ltd, for two medical waste incinerators and one animal crematory expired on 5 August 2025.
2. Payment for the application fees (3x \$90) was received (receipt 9555 for \$270 on 9 October 2025)
3. The complete annual report, due one month before expiry, has not been received to date. A partial report was emailed by Yuri Lightbourne to Patricia Hollis on 9 October 2025 despite DENR requests that communications be sent to pollutioncontrol@gov.bm. Mr. Lightbourne was sent an email by Patricia Hollis on 23 October 2025 requesting a full annual report to be submitted promptly. This has not yet been received.
4. DENR has received complaints of smoke from MediWaste Facility fouling the air of nearby businesses on 7 October 2025 and 3 November 2025. It was DENR that notified MediWastes of these emission excursions. MediWaste did not notify DENR as required in condition 26 (reporting of upset conditions)
5. DENR requested a copy of the full incident report for the 3 November 2025 excursion as required to be logged in the Complaints Log (condition 23). To date only an incomplete one has been received. An email was sent by Patricia Hollis to Yuri Lightbourne, copied to Allan Hunt and Donte Hunt, on 4 November requesting additional details. To date, no revised incident report has been received.

In light of missed deadlines for reporting, the Environmental Authority requests representatives from MediWaste to attend their next meeting, scheduled for 3 pm, Wednesday 26 November in the DENR boardroom, Botanical Gardens, Paget.

DENR would recommend that you aim to address the late deliverables listed above immediately.
