<p>Friday, November 1st</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [redacted] met with the Canadian Consulate. • [redacted] was locked down for 3 days for being disrespectful to [redacted] • [redacted] was locked down for a further 3 days for being aggressive toward [redacted] by [redacted]
<p>Saturday, November 2nd</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A positive Covid case was identified this morning, [redacted]. As he is kitchen worker, all inmates that were in the kitchen the last few were tested by Medical, with negative results. Some persons in Medium Housing Units 2&3 had also expressed not feeling well. They were advised to report any concerns. [redacted] informed the staff and population to be precautionous. • Duress was activated by [redacted] in E2. [redacted] became aggressive and assaulted [redacted] was transferred to Segregation for 4 hrs, then transferred back to E2. He was placed on charge.

Sunday, November 3rd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At approximately 0015 hours remand [redacted] was searched after observations of him rolling what appeared to be a cigarette type paper. During the search, two plastic packages of green plant like material was found. These items were shown to the remand [redacted]. The items were handed over to the police.
Monday, November 4th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was locked down for 3 days for having cell window obstructed after previously being warned. [redacted] was placed on charge for disrespecting [redacted] and making derogatory comments. [redacted] was locked down for 3 days for smoking in his cell. E2 & E3 was tested for Covid. Three inmates in E2 remain positive.
Tuesday, November 5th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was transferred from E1 to Seg for consistently offending against Prison Rules
Thursday, November 7th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> High School Graduation Equivalency ceremony was held in the chapel [redacted], and [redacted] were the graduates. The ceremony was attended by [redacted] Custody staff and Family and Friends.
Friday, November 8th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] met with the Canadian Consulate. [redacted] was locked down for 3 days for being disrespectful to [redacted]. [redacted] was locked down for a further 3 days for being aggressive toward [redacted].

Monday, November 11th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was placed on charge for throwing the pod's dinner over the walls in Max. [redacted] was placed on charge for being disrespectful to I [redacted] by stating "get the fuck out of my cell" [redacted] was placed on charge for being disrespectful and [redacted]
Wednesday, November 13th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was admitted to KEMH after receiving Out Patient Surgery.
Friday, November 15th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] father called to inform him that his oldest sister has passed. He was given calls to the family. [redacted], was escorted to KEMH after the Remand bathroom door hit him in the forehead. Apparently, the shower door was stuck and [redacted] kicked the door to open it and unfortunately [redacted] was to close behind the door. [redacted] was fired from the kitchen after becoming unco-operative and irate when ordered to go to his cell by [redacted]. He kicked over the trash can and meal tray and then started banging on the main entrance door. He was ordered to his cell and secured by [redacted].
Sunday, November 17th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was placed on charge for tempering with the kitchen gate security lock.

<p>Tuesday, November 19th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [redacted] was informed that his daughter passed away. He was given calls to his family. • [redacted] was transferred to Seg. For 15 min observation. • [redacted] was transferred to RLH • [redacted] was put on charge by [redacted] for having brew in his cell. • [redacted] was placed on suicide watch with 15 min observations.
<p>Wednesday, November 20th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • E3 lockdown was delayed when the hot water for the showers was not working. • [redacted] were moved to ½ hour observations.

<p>Friday, November 22nd</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The facilities last Covid inmate tested out today. The Facility is now deemed Covid free.
