During [redacted] checks, at 0515hrs rem [redacted] was lying on his back I his bed. At 0630hrs [redacted] was making his rounds. He stated the rem [redacted] was lying in bed on his left side and appeared to be asleep.
Tuesday 30th September	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Morpheus Project started September 30th at 0930hrs to 1130hrs every Tuesday. This is a 5-week course. Instructor [redacted] has permission to enter the facility with a laptop for instructional purposes.

TOOB's have been postponed due the approach of hurricane [redacted]. New date to be determined. Remand [redacted] is now on 30-minute observation. Remand [redacted] was assaulted this morning in Remand unit, by Remand [redacted] and [redacted]. He was taken to Health Service and assessed. Remand [redacted] is pressing charges and has been moved to Segregation. [redacted] in to take his statement
Thursday 2nd October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hurricane Imelda passed throughout Wednesday night into early Thursday morning. Inside and outside perimeter check completed by [redacted] Brew was found in the kitchen by [redacted] at 1100hrs. in a mayonnaise bottle in the bakery area. Pictures were taken and the brew was discarded. Wellness Check on Remand [redacted] housed at MAWI. He is in good spirits. Outside recreation resumed at 1330hrs for Medium Housing Units. The Minister and Senior Staff thanked everyone for working during the hurricane.

Remand [redacted] was taken to Health Services for a split lip and Remand [redacted] was transported to Segregation. Form 17 and 35 are pending. Remand [redacted] was moved from Max - Pod 4 to Segregation for threatening words. Form 35 to follow.

Officers need to meet truck on arrival to Intake. • [redacted] has been placed on 15 minutes continual suicide observations with 15 minutes documentation until next Wednesday.

Contraband was handed over to [redacted] who were still in the facility. • Imp [redacted] had a call with the Brazilian Consulate this morning • Rem [redacted] continues, with continuous suicide observations.
