[redacted] pressed his duress after [redacted] threw his food out of his cell, stating that he did not want it and for [redacted] : “to close his fucking door”. [redacted] was moved to Segregation. |

[redacted] became verbally aggressive when his daughter was escorted out to the gate to wait for the child’s mother to collect her. As [redacted] walked towards the runway gate, [redacted] intercepted him and spoke with him. He soon returned to his unit. |
