Friday 2nd May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3-day Lock down. Remand For being disrespectful to by saying “shut the fuck up” after asked him to calm down when he was speaking to her.
Saturday 3rd May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> was informed by family that his uncle had passed. He was given calls and offered the help of the chaplaincy. had his visit ceased after being observed receiving contraband during a visit in the visit area. Contra band was confiscated. Visitors were escorted off the property and inmate was placed on charge. Maximum Security pod 5 cell 8 door locked open. Works department notified for immediate repair. All inmates secured in their cells and appeared correct.
Monday 5th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Special search conducted in maximum security by and the following was found.) 1 pink silicone vagina and 2 glass bottles with unknown liquid. Inmate a spork made into a shank was confiscated.

Inmate [redacted] from remand to medium housing unit two cell 8. Transferred in from the Prison Farm inmate [redacted] housed in E3 cell 10. • Remand [redacted] has been placed on 15 minute observation with 15 minute documentation as per health services. • The gate near the kitchen does not lock therefore a chain and lock has been temporarily put in place until repaired by Works Officer. • Inmate [redacted] had a phone call with Canadian Consulate today at 1330 hrs.
<p>Wednesday 7th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [redacted] facilitated a zoom meeting for Remand [redacted] with his children in New Jersey. • TOOBS into Westgate • The following inmates were Urine tested and results are as follows: [redacted] positive K2 and THC [redacted] positive for K2 and THC [redacted] positive THC [redacted] positive for K2 • Remand [redacted] has been placed on 30 observation after being assessed by psychiatrist. Now moved from segregation to remand cell 32.
<p>Thursday 8th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Information received from [redacted] the mother of [redacted] regarding the death of this sister. He was seen and spoken to by [redacted] and the Psychologist [redacted] [redacted] was escorted to KEMH by [redacted] and [redacted] to have final words with his sister. • Reports regarding the hygiene of [redacted] made by unit officers were concerning. Cleaning supplies were issued and inmate encouraged to clean and shower
<p>Friday 9th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [redacted] received news that his child's mother has passed away. He did not take the news well. He was seen by psychologist [redacted] to assist him in his time of grief. • Staff appreciation BBQ held at Westgate from 1200 – 1500 hrs. All those that participated enjoyed themselves.
<p>Saturday 10th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [redacted] received information that inmate [redacted] mother was in the hospital and not doing well. Escort was arranged, executed by [redacted]
<p>Sunday 11th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Water was observed between the Max and remand entrance door. Water has been shut off until repairs have been made. • Water leak in Maximum Security Pod 3 chase between cell 1 and 3. Issues need to be addressed.
<p>Monday 12th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 1144 Duress was activated by [redacted] while on duty in the Remand Unit, there was a physical altercation between Remands [redacted] and [redacted]. Both individuals were taken to segregation and placed on charge for their actions.



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The entrance doors to Pod 5 and Pod 6 in Maximum Security are very stiff. Works officers have been informed and will address. (Fixed 5/13/25)
Wednesday 14th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Special search conducted in Maximum Security Pod 5 cell 2 which houses inmate [redacted]. Officers conducting the search were [redacted] and [redacted], items found were 2 cigarette lighters and a small twist of tobacco in cell.
Thursday 15th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Three-day lockdown for inmates [redacted] and [redacted] for refusing to unblock their observation window of their cell as per [redacted]. Inmate [redacted] has commenced 30 minute observations by health services. Inmate [redacted] has commenced 30 minute observation due to the nature of his offence as per [redacted]. At 1528 Emergency escort to KEMH Remand [redacted] for further assessment regarding pain to left knee and ankle. Escorting officers were [redacted] and [redacted]; Ret 2246 At 1845 Emergency Escort to KEMH Imprisonment [redacted] for further assessment regarding headaches and tightening of tingers. Escorting officers were [redacted] and [redacted] Ret 2342
Friday 16th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Viewing of stepfather: [redacted] out Amis Funeral home. [redacted] in care of [redacted]
Saturday 17th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inmate [redacted] has been placed on charge for disrespecting [redacted] during his night patrol check. Reports pending. [redacted] alerted to [redacted] during a security check before entering visits. She consented to a secondary search which was conducted and nothing was found ([redacted]). Remand [redacted] viewed the funeral of his step father in the boardroom. He was grateful and thankful for the privilege. Police into Westgate to collect [redacted] (warrant of detention). Duress activated by [redacted] in Medium Housing Unit two as inmate [redacted] was found on the floor in the multi-purpose room. Officers responsible, he was seen by [redacted] who determined that 911 should be called, and inmate transported to KEMH for further assessment and treatment. After assessment it was determined that inmate [redacted] will be admitted for treatment.
Sunday 18th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Imp [redacted] still admitted to KEMH for treatment and has moved to Ascendant ke room 6.
Monday 19th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] found 1 white apple Iphone in pod 3 cell 7 housed by inmate [redacted] was out on court escort when the canine alerted to his cell. [redacted] found the phone in the left side of light. Inmate not charged as he was not present when the item was found. Duress activated in maximum security as rem [redacted] was found unresponsive on the floor of Pod 6. Taken to health services for treatment and further assessment.



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<p>Monday 26th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [redacted] returned to Westgate and is now housed in the medium housing unit two cell 42. • [redacted] want to wish all officers involved in the duress a speedy recovery and they are in their prayers.
<p>Tuesday 27th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transferred in from Prison farm inmate [redacted] for verbally disrespecting officer. • [redacted] and [redacted] into Westgate to interview [redacted] as per his request. • Duress activated in Medium Housing 2 by [redacted] as [redacted] was found in cell 9 where he is housed in an unresponsive state. • 911 was contacted for assistance, emergency services responded and inmate taken to KEMH for treatment. [redacted] returned to Westgate and will now be housed in Administrative Segregation cell 2. • UK Spanish Consulate had a virtual meeting with [redacted] • Remand [redacted] placed on charge for using offensive language towards Divisional Officer [redacted] during night patrol while she was making here checks.
<p>Wednesday 28th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff meeting held and well attended. • Special search conducted in Medium Housing Unit 2 cell 2 which houses imp [redacted] by [redacted] and [redacted] nothing found. Information received that he had posted on Facebook.
<p>Thursday 29th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Escort viewing [redacted] and [redacted] in care of imprisonment [redacted] to Amis Funeral Home to view his sister. • During night patrol Imp [redacted] complained that he couldn't breathe. On call nurse contacted and instructed that he be given Asma pumps with instructions. • Also, during night patrol [redacted] seen keeled over the bed in his cell. He was seen by the on-call nurse in health services, that returned to the unit in a wheelchair to be secured in cell. He was unresponsive and slumped in the wheelchair. 911 contacted for assistance and inmate transferred to KEMH for further assessment.
<p>Friday 30th May</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emergency Escort returned from KEMH with [redacted] at 0821hrs. • Court Services into Westgate to see remand [redacted] in visits to conduct assessment. • [redacted] into programs to elaborate on the game of chess. • Imp [redacted] viewed the funeral of his sister virtually in the chapel at Westgate, [redacted] assisted with this (Manny Thanks). • Inmate [redacted] was found not guilty by the jury for : Murder / Using a firearm whilst committing an indictable offence.



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Water leak in medium housing unit three between cells 33- 35. Officer [redacted] has addressed the situation. Imp [redacted] viewed the funeral of his cousin online in the board room. Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment.
Tuesday 20th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment.
Wednesday 21th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 day lockdown [redacted] for stealing canteen from another inmate. Department of Child and Family services into see Imp [redacted] Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment.
Thursday 22nd May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PORC Work party out of facility inmates [redacted] Clothes sent to KEMH to inmate [redacted] via the court truck. (2 sets of clothes and underwear) Online funeral viewing for inmate [redacted] in chapel of his cousin ([redacted]) Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment
Friday 23th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BERMUDA DAY Fire alarm activated in kitchen, BBQ outside on landing caused alarm to go off. Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment.
Saturday 24th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Security gate behind E2 affixed by one hinge. Report sent to works officer. Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment.
Sunday 25th May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Treatment of Offenders Board members [redacted] and [redacted] into Westgate on Rota visit. Duress activated in Maximum Security by [redacted] While the TOOB's were on there visit in maximum security talking to [redacted] he was distracted as the K9 entered the area. He immediately abandoned the TOOBs to attend his room in event to conceal contraband (2 Phones). were amongst other officers retrieved the two cellphones after a short struggle. Inmate was transferred to segregation as he was uncompliant, no more force than necessary was used to secure him. During this situation 5 officers were injured and received medical attention at KEMH. Imp [redacted] also received treatment at KEMH. [redacted] attended facility and updated on circumstances regarding duress. The main door to the CCR was locked and unable to be unlock as designed. Locksmith was unable to be contacted therefore access was made from the sallyport area. (Locksmith addressed issue Monday May 26, 2025 in the am.) Imp [redacted] remains in KEMH for treatment



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Saturday 31th
May

- Cameras have gone down in Intake and segregation, [redacted] contacted and technician [redacted] into the facility to make repairs.
- Inmate [redacted] was awarded a three-day lockdown by [redacted] for answering the E2 unit phone.
- Approximately 1710 hrs [redacted] reported that remand [redacted] was lying on the floor oh his cell disorientated to [redacted]. On call nurse was contacted and reported to the facility to access the situation. After review, inmate was transferred to KEMH via ambulance for treatment. [redacted] was in the ambulance while [redacted] followed in prison vehicle IN2310.

☛ was seen by the Parole Board, and there were no objections for the recommendation to be released to Men's Treatment Center on or about May 15th 2025.

Having been granted parole, ☛ was advised he will again see the Board at their next meeting where he will read and sign, the Parole Licence, outlining the following special conditions below:

- To successfully complete the Men's Treatment Center Program with Aftercare to include residing on the property
- Attend self help groups as advised by Court Services
- To be fitted with an EMD for the first 6 months, and thereafter at the discretion of Court Services
- Refrain from associating with individuals who have a criminal record, or suspected of being involved with illegal activities
- Refrain from frequenting environments deemed negative by Court Services
- To be assessed for and to successfully complete all programs deemed suitable by the Department of Court Services
- To refrain from the use of all illicit substances and to submit to random urine screening at the discretion of Court Services
