Dear Mr Piper,

I am writing to you in relation to the captioned matter.

I have received correspondence from the Ombudsman today indicating that you have filed a complaint as it relates to an application you filed with the Courts at the end of January 2021. I apologize for any difficulties you may have experienced in receiving a response on the status of this matter. As the Registrar (Head) of the Courts, your queries and/or concerns were not brought to my attention. If you have any difficulties moving forward, please write an email to [supremecourt@gov.bm](mailto:supremecourt@gov.bm) and your query will be addressed.

In relation to your initial application as well as the injunction application you filed on 12 March 2021 please note the following:

(a) In addition to the normal processing time, we have had to secure an Assistant Justice to deal with your matters as all the Judges in the Civil/Commercial Section of the Supreme Court are conflicted. This process required three Justices to review the file in the first instance to make the determination he or she is conflicted which would also add to processing time. Additionally, due to upcoming trials and the COA Session being conducted between 1 and 19 March 2021, it had been particularly challenging to secure an Assistant Justice.

Having said this, I can confirm that we received confirmation this afternoon of an Assistant Justice who can have conduct of your matters. Your application for leave and your Ex-Parte Summons for an Injunction will be reviewed by the said Assistant Justice tomorrow. You will then be advised as of the outcome of these applications or advised if you is required to attend Court if the Assistant Justice wishes to hear from you in person to determine these applications.

(b) As it relates to this case being listed in the Supreme Court Cause Book, I can confirm this matter has been entered into the Cause Book; however, it is marked as "Space Taken" due to the nature of the application. If your application for leave is successful the matter will be formally listed in the Cause Book. This is the process for all Judicial Review cases.

I hope this assists in addressing the concerns you have had. If you have further concerns or queries please do not hesitate to contact me, particularly if you are not contacted tomorrow by someone from the Courts as it specifically relates to the outcome of your applications which I referred to above.
