3. Will the Honourable Minister please inform this Honourable House of the breakdown by school for upgrades and renovations for the past five years, showing details of the work undertaken and the associated cost?

The Government welcomes the opportunity to provide this Honourable House with a comprehensive account of the investments made in school upgrades and renovations over the past five years, from 2021/2022 to 2025/2026.

In response to the Parliamentary Question, the Ministry of Education has compiled a detailed breakdown, by school, across the four major expenditure categories that support the safety, functionality, and learning environment of our public schools:

1. School Minor Works
2. School Safety
3. School Bathroom Renovations
4. School Equipment

These categories capture the range of upgrades undertaken—from essential repairs and compliance-related improvements to targeted enhancements that directly support teaching and learning.

The information presented reflects the Ministry's ongoing commitment to the continuous improvement of school facilities for students and staff.

Expenditures span preschools, primary schools, middle schools, our special school and our alternative programme.

SCHOOL MINOR WORKS

Funding for School Minor Works is utilized to support essential upgrades and improvements across our public school facilities. This budget provides for the supply and installation of non-skid, non-wax vinyl plank flooring; the supply and installation of PVC windows and frames; classroom cabinetry; the installation of air-conditioning units; and the supply and installation of Elkay bottle-filling stations. These works ensure that our learning environments remain safe, modern, and fit-for-purpose for students and staff across the system.

SCHOOL SAFETY

The funds allocated for School Safety are utilized to support a range of critical health and safety initiatives across our school system. This includes air-quality testing and the remedial works recommended as a result of those assessments; the purchase and installation of electric patient-hoist lifts; asbestos testing and remediation works; the installation of school-safety fencing; and the provision of safety handrails. These investments ensure that our school environments remain safe, compliant, and supportive of the wellbeing of students and staff.

These works ensure that our school bathrooms remain safe, hygienic, and compliant with current building and safety requirements for the benefit of students and staff.
