Saturday March 8th	Movement from Remand to Segregation: [redacted] for throwing coffee at Remand [redacted]
Friday March 9th	Inmates in the Medium Housing units complained about their chicken not cooked right through. The chicken was sent back and recooked. There were no other complaints.
Monday March 10th	Imp [redacted] is no longer a working in the Kitchen. While conducting NP checks in Remand, [redacted] was able to hear inmate [redacted] engaged in a conversation in his cell. [redacted] and [redacted] entered cell #4 and found inmate [redacted] seated at his desk talking on a black cell phone. The cell phone was confiscated along with 1 charger block and 1 make-shift charger cord and 1 sim card. He was placed on charge.
Thursday March 13th	Discharge: [redacted] – Released by the Minister – State Now #103. Special search conducted in Segregation on Remand [redacted] by [redacted] with [redacted] and [redacted] – (1) Alcatel cellphone, (1) twist of plant-like material, (1) Twist of white substance. Items were photograph and sent out with the police. He has been informed that he is placed on charge. Transfer to RLH [redacted] – State Now #102 Inmate [redacted] received 2 years to run consecutive to his current sentence for assault on [redacted]
Friday March 14th	GED [redacted] came in to tutor inmate [redacted]. Discharge: [redacted] – Deported – State Now #101 Search conducted on the laundry from Remand going to the laundry by [redacted].
